**JOB VACANCY**

We are looking to appoint a **Benefice Administrator**.

The Administrator will help us to maintain efficient administration of the Benefice of Wolverton (Holy Trinity Church and St George's Church).

**Key areas of responsibility**

1. A friendly and welcoming first point of contact with the church for the general public;
2. Administration of and clear record keeping for the occasional offices (weddings, Christenings, funerals;)
3. Administrative support and preparation of materials for regular worship and services within the benefice;
4. Management of administration for occasional church lettings.

Contract offered on a PAYE basis at £10.41 per hour (including paid holiday) for an estimated 8 hours per week. The Administrator will be provided with the Benefice laptop, a dongle for internet access and the Benefice mobile phone. The place of work is flexible, though you would be required to work on two Saturdays of the month at St George's Church (10am - 12noon) to be able to meet people looking to book a Christening or a wedding, etc.

The remaining working hours would need be regular each week but could be arranged to suit the successful candidate.
