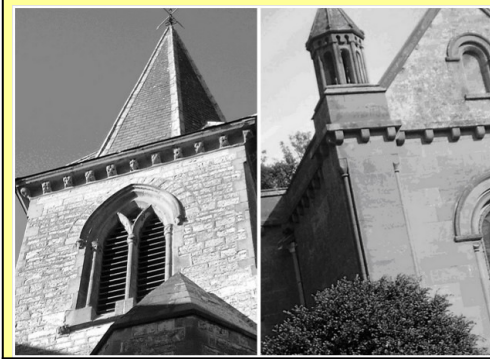
Almighty and everlasting God,

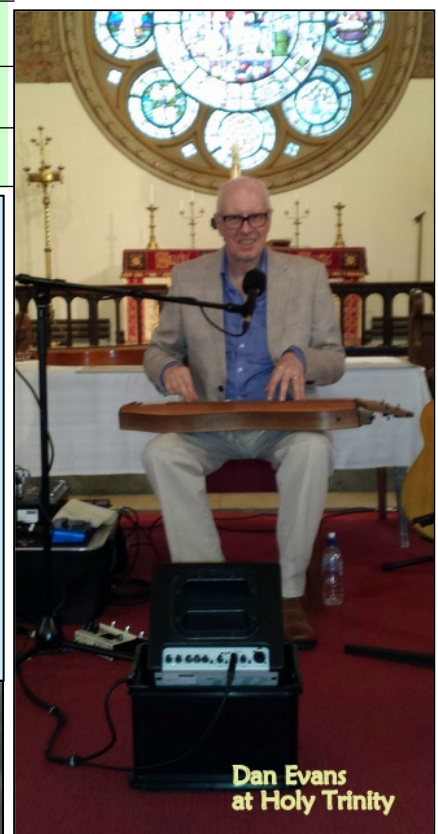
