A 'My Guide' donates approximately 2-3 hours per week (days flexible) to supporting a person with sight loss as they try to achieve their mobility goals, such as visiting a coffee shop or becoming more familiar with a walking route to a train station in order to become more independent with travel. Popular legend has it that on 31st October 1517, Martin Luther defiantly nailed a copy of his 95 Theses, criticising the Church's practice of selling indulgences, to the door of Wittenberg Cathedral.
